

Dear Parents,

If a nuclear incident at the Beaver Valley Power Station requires the evacuation of our students during the school day, you or someone designated by you will be required to come directly to ELCS and pick up your child. Any students remaining in our building after 8:00 PM will be bussed to the Columbiana County Career Center located on State Route 45 near Lisbon. Parents and legal guardians will be requested to pick up their children at this host school. Emergency cancellations will be announced by the same method we use on snow days. The stations to listen to are WFMJ TV 21 and WKBN TV 27 in Youngstown, and WTOV Channel 9 in Steubenville. These arrangements have been set-up by the Emergency Management Agency of Columbiana County.

Because our school is located outside the 10-mile Plume Exposure Pathway Zone (EPZ) students will remain in our building and under our care until you or your designee arrive. Should there be a need for students to be transported to the Career Center at 8:00 PM they will be accompanied by our school personnel.

We are concerned that any evacuation be safe and orderly, that accurate attendance be maintained, and that parents/guardians be reunited with students as quickly as possible. Do not rush. Keep school driveways and roads accessible. Drive safely. Your child will be waiting for you under our supervision.

Children may only be released to parents or their designee. Please complete the attached form, designating who can pick up your child.

In order to insure the safety of all the children, we request the cooperation of all parents.
